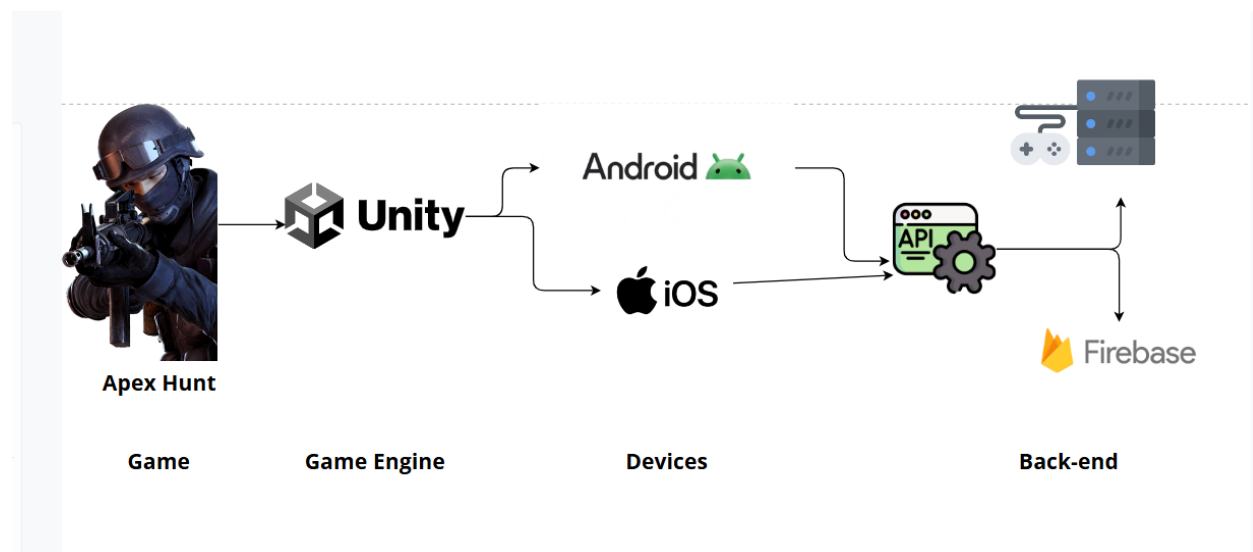

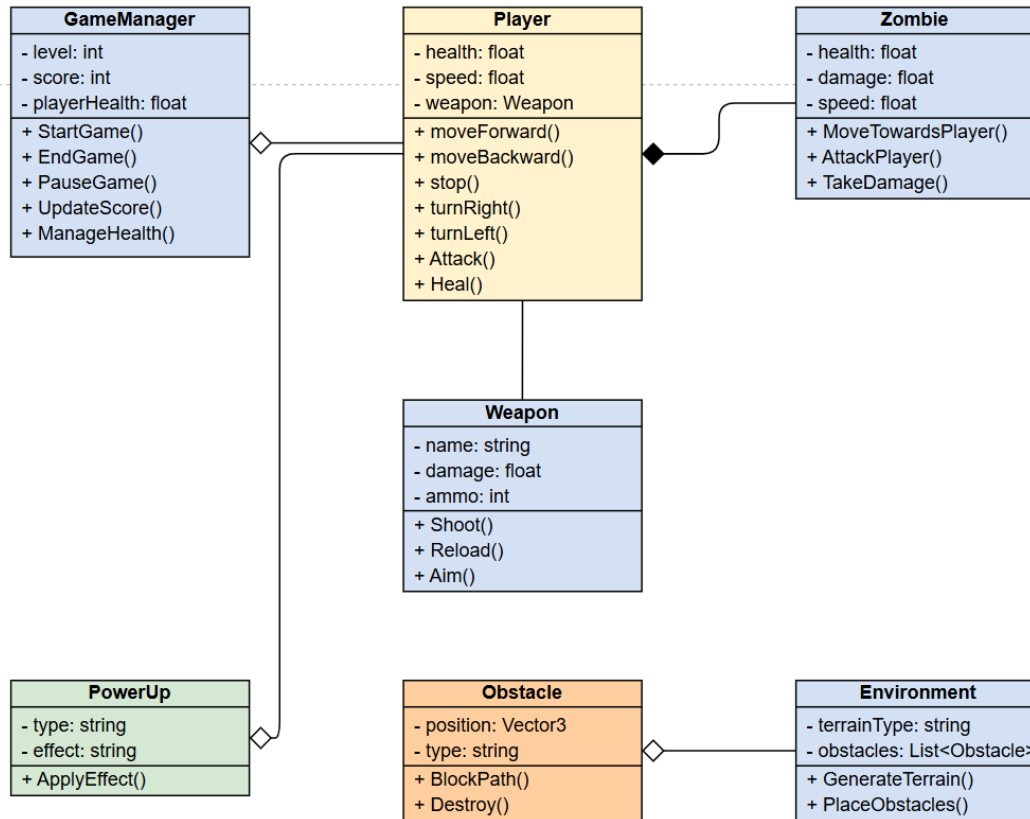

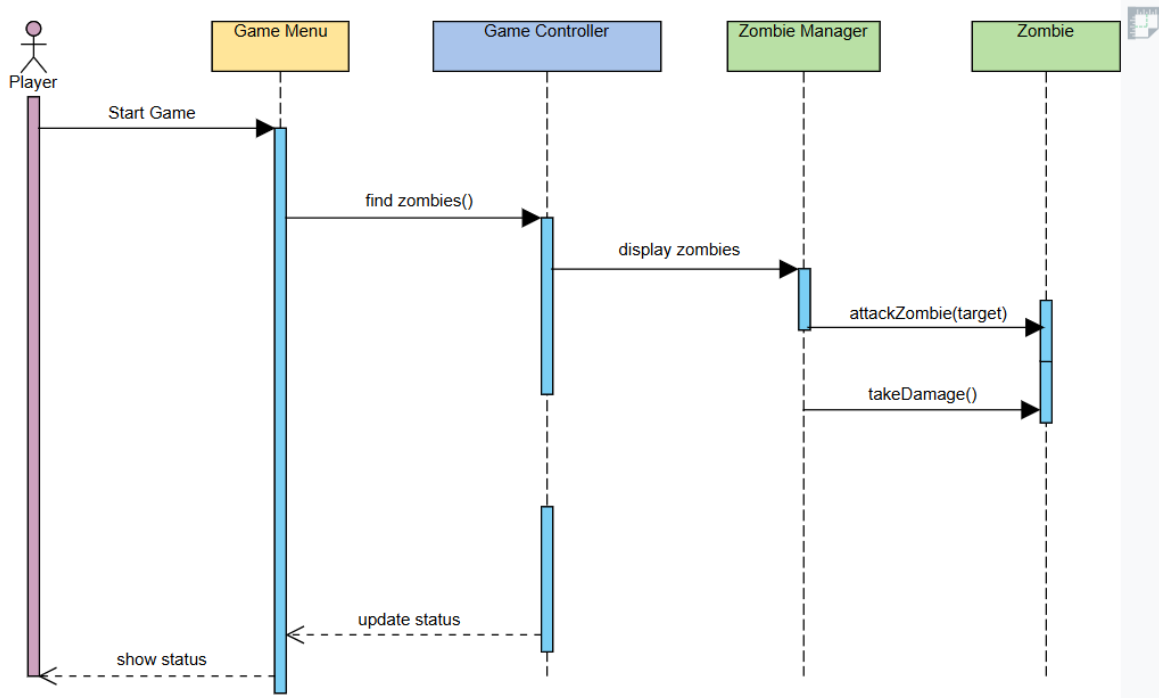
Data Flow

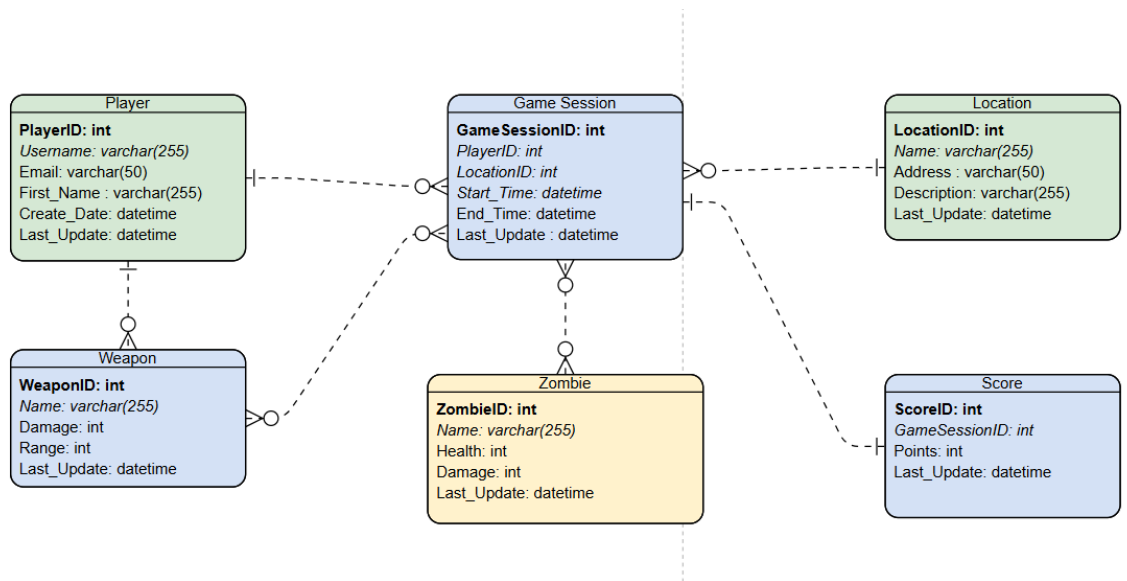

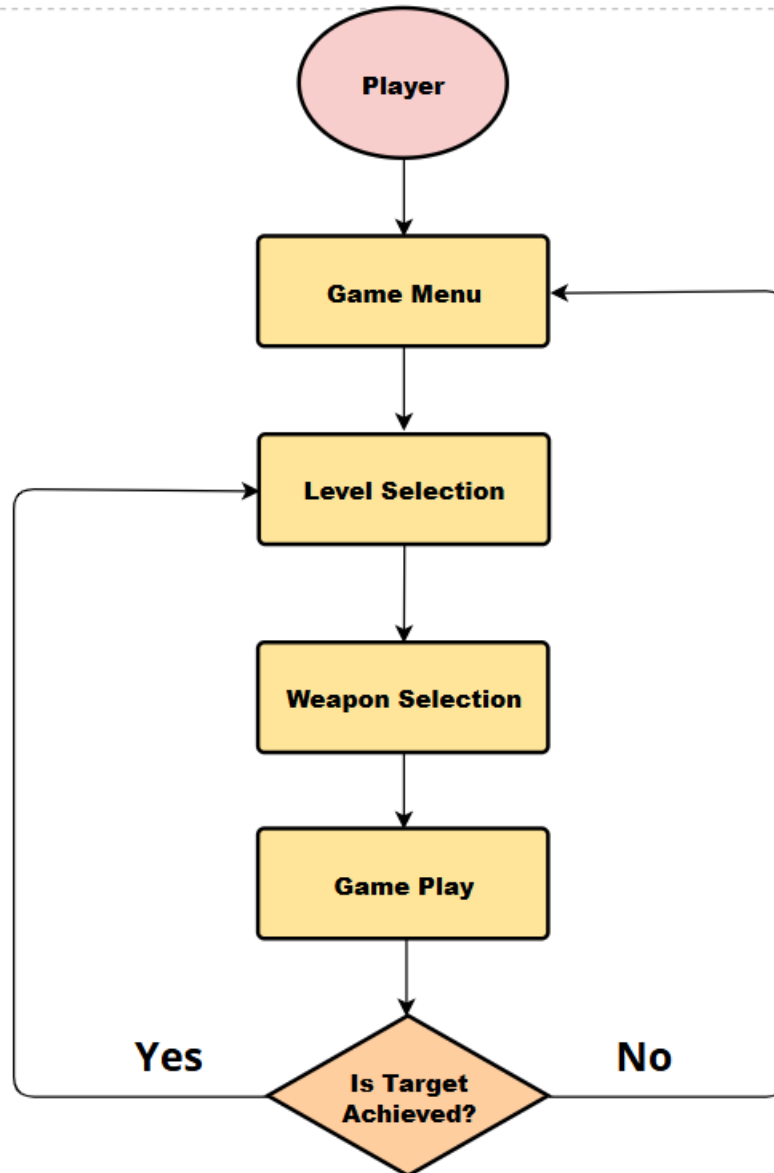
4.3 Sequence Diagram
